



WARM HEARTS FOR WORSHIP CAPITAL CAMPAIGN

The church boiler has died and needs to be replaced. In addition, a number of the split AC/Heating units, (those are the units mounted in the walls), have also died.



In order to make the necessary repairs to properly heat and cool our building, we have undertaken a capital campaign we've called "Warm Hearts for Worship." The estimated cost for the entire project is \$130,000: \$70,000 for the new boiler and \$60,000 for the new split units. So far, we have received \$98,082.18 in gifts to help fund the campaign. Praise God! Thank you to all who have made a donation. "God is able to do immeasurably more than all we ask or imagine."
