Message Title: “Made to Worship” Jim Jennings

Series: Summer in the Psalms

Scripture: Psalm 29:1-2

Date: June 19th, 2026

Psalm 29:1-2 “Ascribe to the LORD, you heavenly beings, ascribe to the LORD glory and strength. ² Ascribe to the LORD the glory due his name; worship the LORD in the splendor of his holiness.”

Worship = worth–ship. It is giving, or as the Psalmist describes it, *ascribing worth* to something or someone.

We are shaped by what we choose to worship: we become like that we worship.

“Human beings by their very nature are worshippers. Worship is not something we do; it defines who we are. You cannot divide human beings into those who worship and those who don’t. Everybody worships; it’s just a matter of what, or whom, we serve.” ~ Paul David Tripp

The psalms reveal to us that worshipping God is not simply a good thing to do – but it is a necessary thing to do to be human and grow into the fullness of the person God has created us to be.
