PERRYSBURG FIRST NEEDS YOU!

Perrysburg First has a history of being known as "Friendly First". We would like to keep that reputation and we can't do it without an adequate Usher Team, a very important ministry of Perrysburg First. (CONT.)

The dream is to have 6 teams (30 ushers) so that each team could serve 2 months per year (not a big commitment!). The minimum we can have is 4 teams (20 ushers), which means a commitment of 3 months per year; this is the level we have been operating at for many years. Going into the 2022-23 church year, we currently have 16 ushers. Needless to say, we need your help!

There are a couple common misconceptions about ushering. First, it takes a very outgoing personality, but that is not true! It only takes a welcoming attitude; truly anyone can do it. If you prefer not to be the person at the door greeting our members and guests, no problem. Many are more comfortable handing out bulletins in the Upper Narthex or quietly working the lift elevator each Sunday. Second, you must have a long history at the church and know everyone, but that could not be further from the truth! Ushering is a great way to get to know faces and meet people in a low-pressure environment.

There is a place for everyone at Perrysburg First and we need you! Should you choose to commit, the months your team is assigned to work, the expectation is 3 out of 4 (or 4 out of 5) Sundays, and subs are easy to find as the core group of ushers are always happy to serve.

STEPHENS MINISTRY

Stephen Ministries is an organization that trains lay people to provide Christian care to those who are hurting or in need. Stephen Ministries was founded in 1975 by Dr. Kenneth Haugk, a pastor and clinical psychologist, who saw that he alone as a pastor could not provide for all the caring ministry needs in his congregation. In Acts Chapter 6 Stephen was chosen by the Apostles to provide a caring ministry to those in need. Since the time of the Apostles, a caring ministry has been considered a hallmark of the Christian faith community. (CONT.)

Why Do We Have Stephen Ministry at Perrysburg First Church?

- To expand pastoral care
- We are called to care and reach out with Christ's love.
- The need for care in our congregation is always there.
- · It fulfills the mission of our congregation to "serve others".

What Does a Stephen Minister Do?

A Stephen Minister gives one-to-one, lay Christian care.

One-to-one: Stephen Ministers are dedicated to meet privately with one care receiver of the same gender.

Lay: Stephen Ministers undergo extensive training and are regularly supervised by Stephen Leaders. They are not professional counselors or therapists, pastors or physicians.

Christian: Stephen Ministers are Christians who care in the name of Christ. They are willing to talk about spiritual issues but won't force them on their care receivers.

Care: Stephen Ministers care by listening, supporting, encouraging and praying for and with their care receiver. They are dependable and trustworthy by meeting with their care receiver on a regular basis.

Confidentiality: Stephen Ministers keep personal information confidential. As a result, a care receiver can feel free to share with their Stephen Minister without worrying that anyone else will know about it.

Who can benefit from the care of a Stephen Minister?

People who are dealing with:

Illness and/or hospitalization

Chronic illness

An ill family member

Family challenges

Death or serious loss

Divorce

Pregnancy / adoption

Etc.

What happens when you ask for help from a Stephen Minister?

When you ask for help, one of our Stephen Leaders, Mary Lauback or Dalynn Badenhop, will contact you to talk more about the program and what it can mean for you. If your needs can be best served by a Stephen Minister, you will be matched with someone who will support you through this tough time.


ADOPT-A-BED
